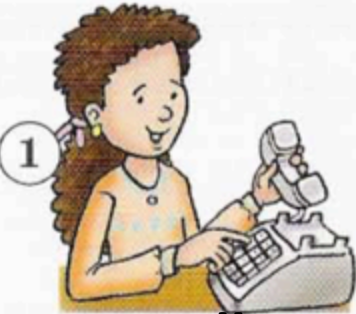

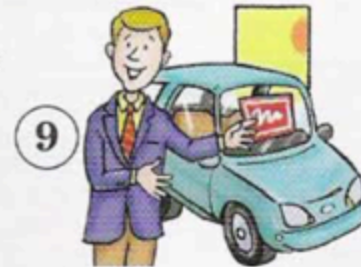

Verb	3rd Person
Speak	Speaks
Play	Plays
Give	Gives
Make	Makes

2. If the verb ends in SS, X, CH, SH or the letter O,
we add + ES in the third person.

- A mechanic **fixes** cars.
- She **watches** soap operas every afternoon.
- He **kisses** his wife before he goes to work.

Verb	3rd Person
Kiss	Kisses
Fix	Fixes
Watch	Watches
Crash	Crashes
Go	Goes

3. If the verb ends in a Consonant + Y, we remove the Y and + IES in the third person.

- Isabel studies every night.
- The baby cries all the time.
- He denies all responsibility.

Verb	3rd Person
Carry	Carries
Hurry	Hurries
Study	Studies
Deny	Denies

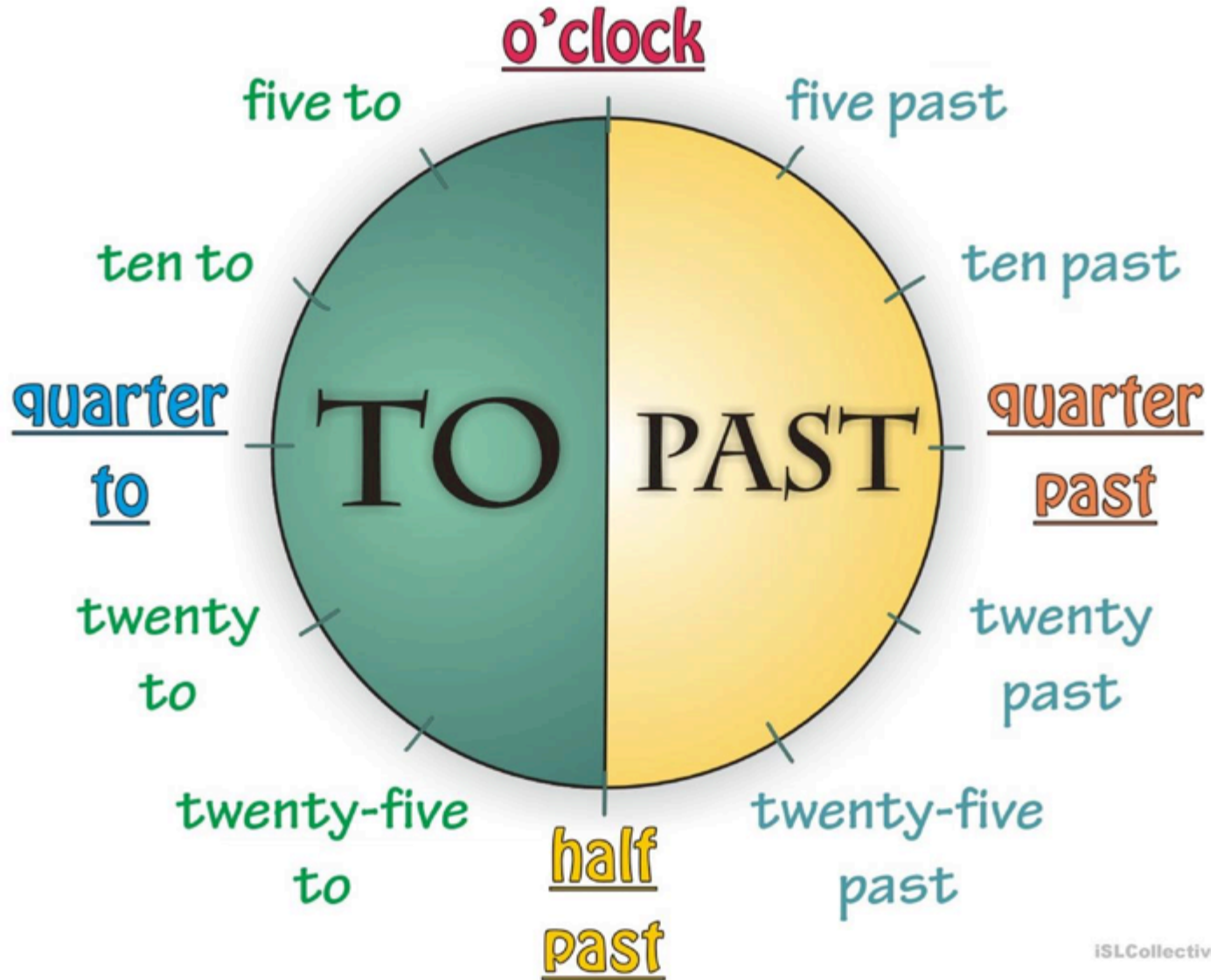

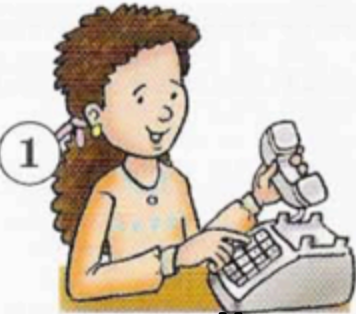
