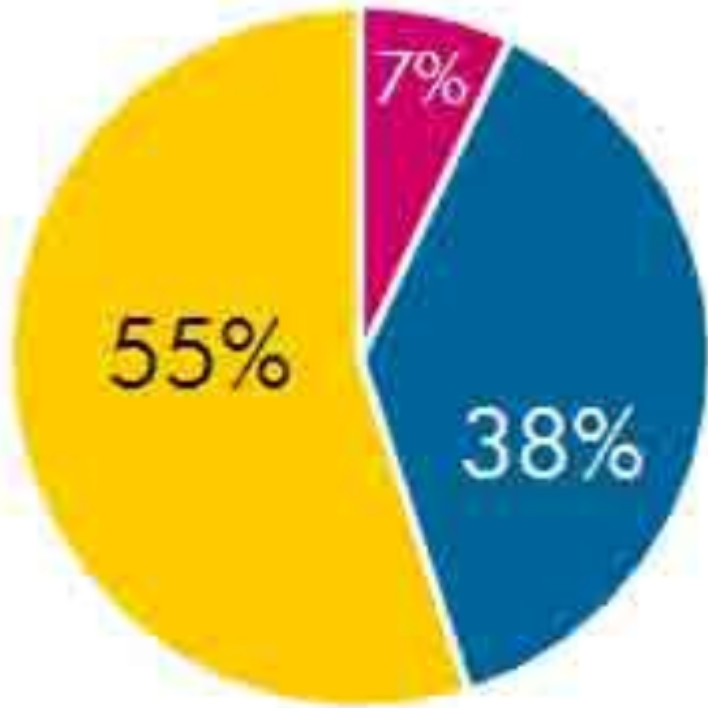

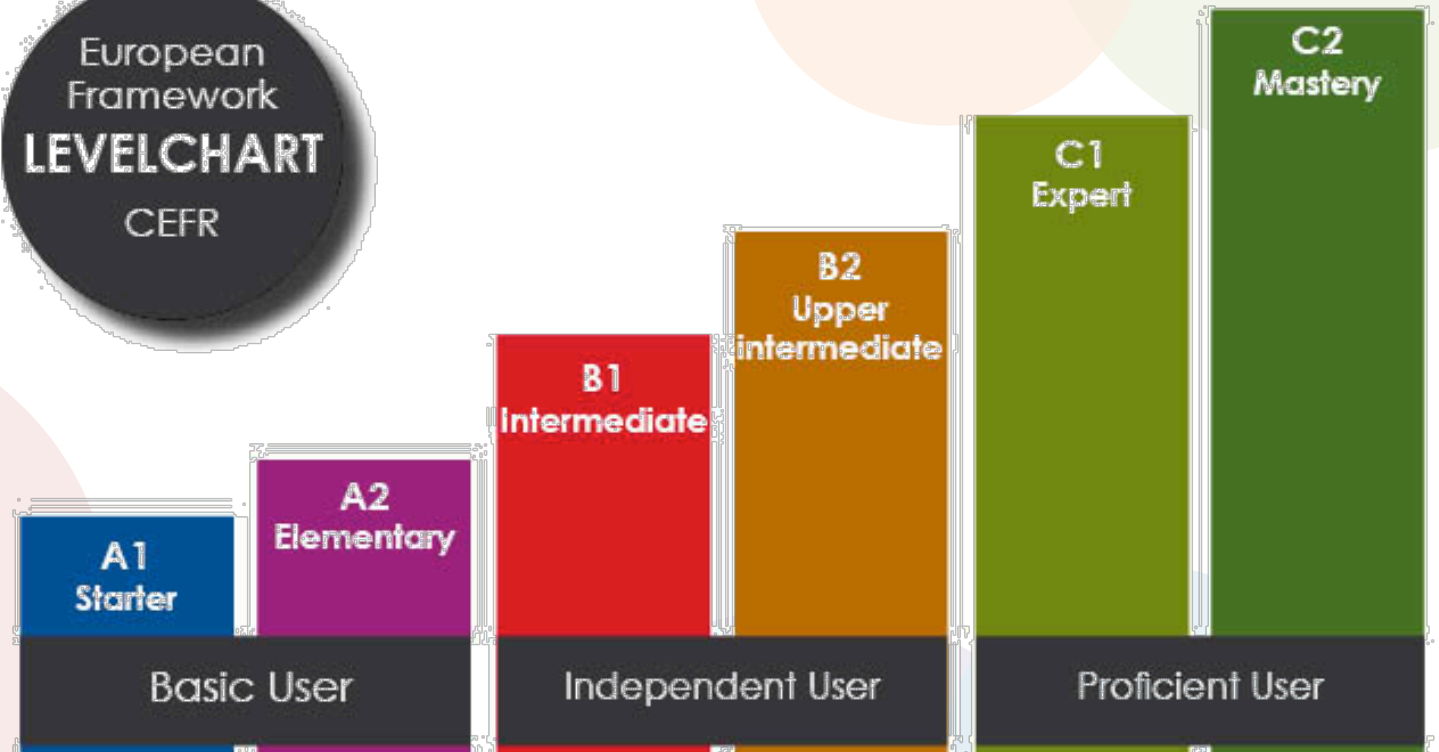

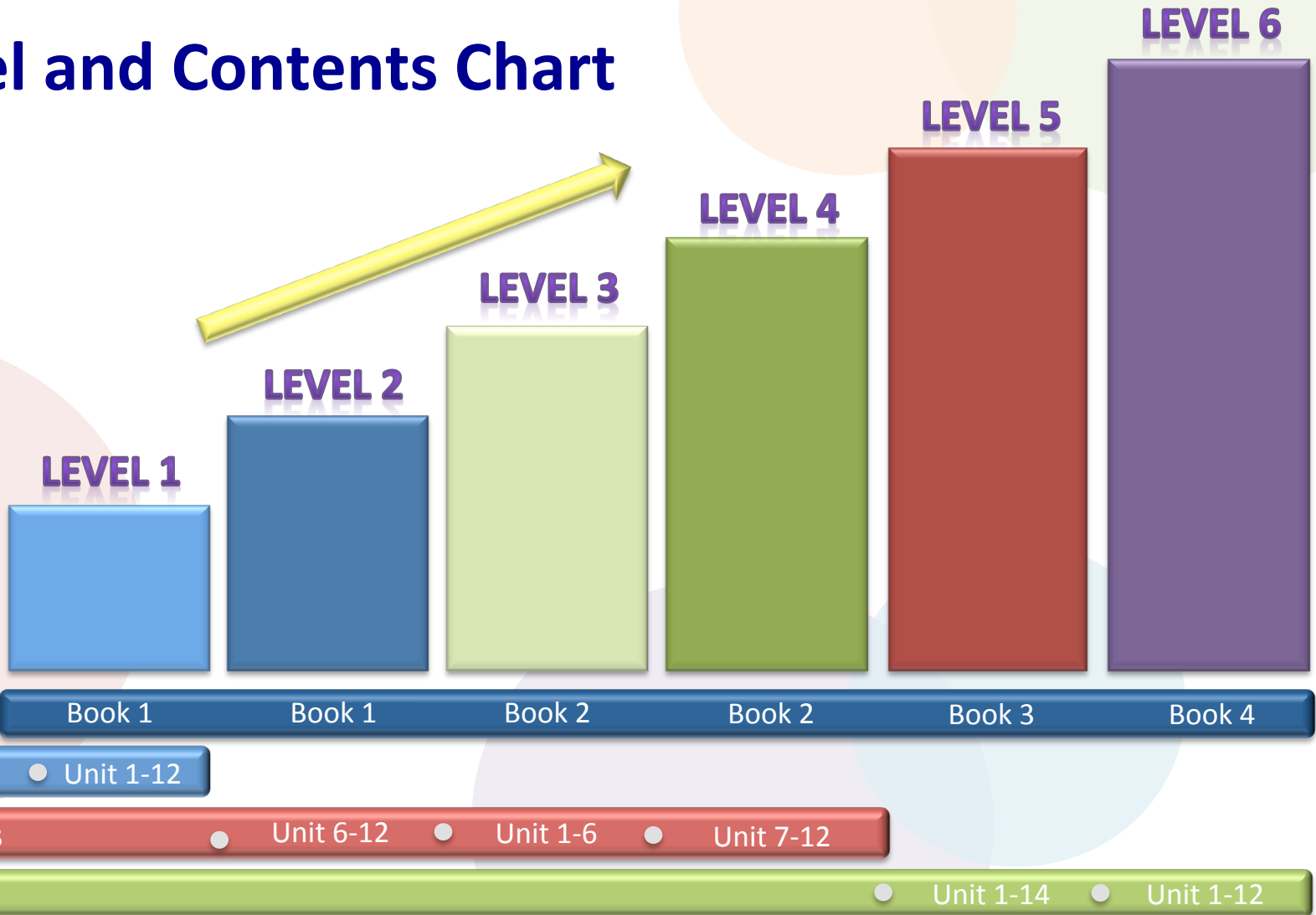

Level and Contents Chart

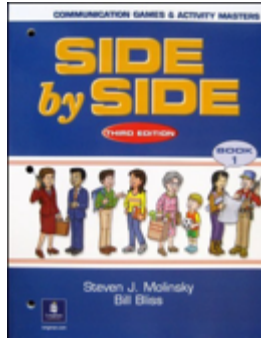
