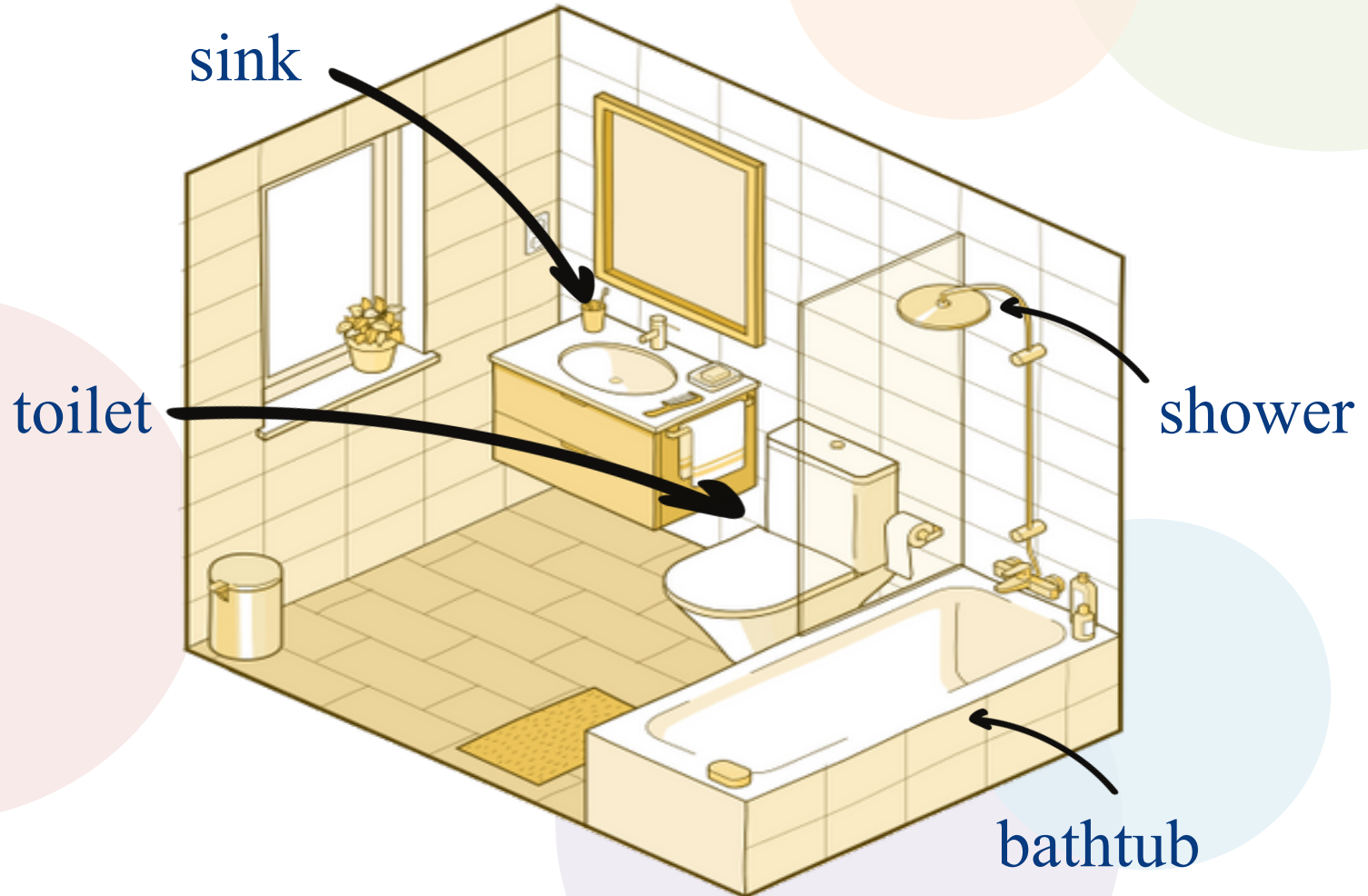

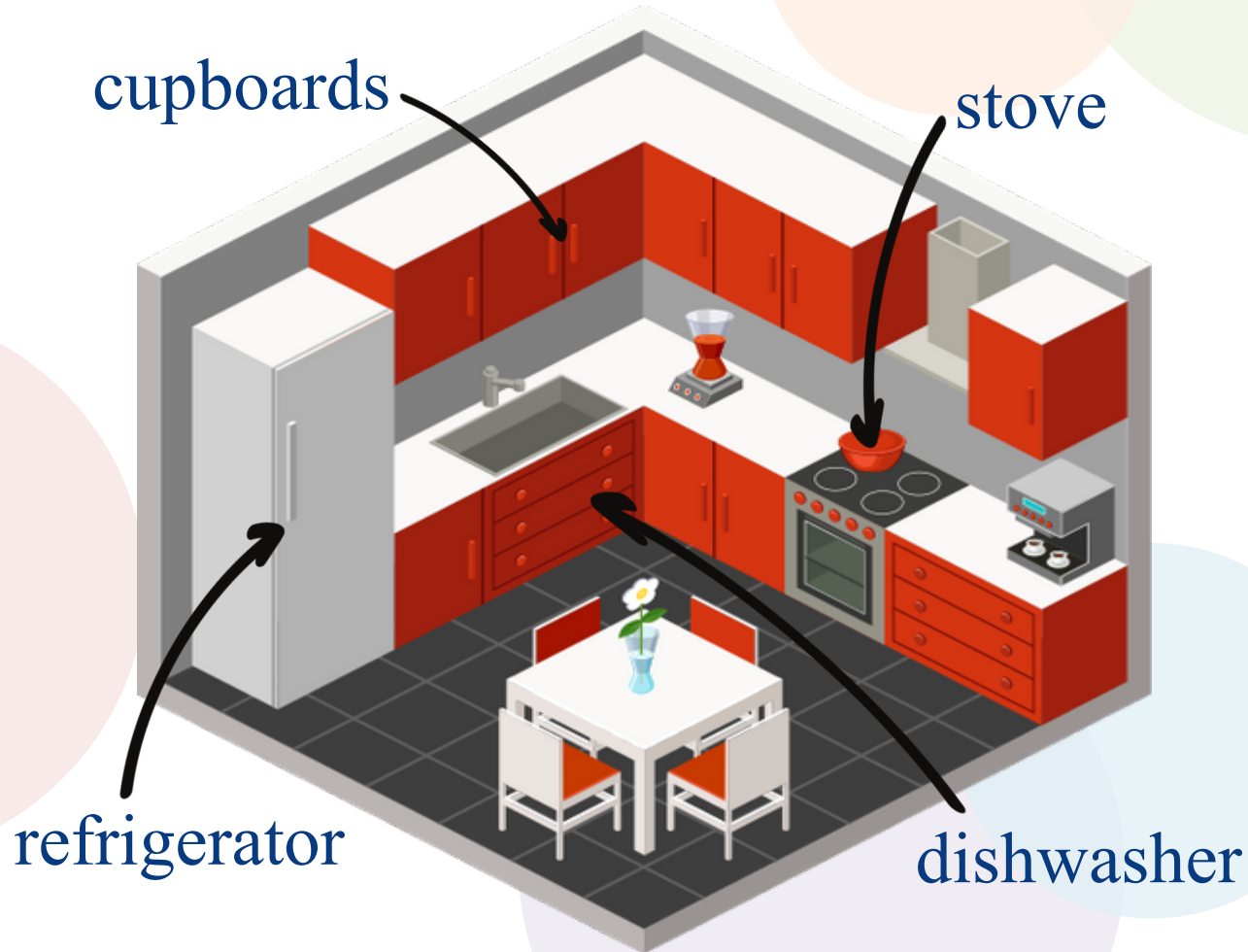

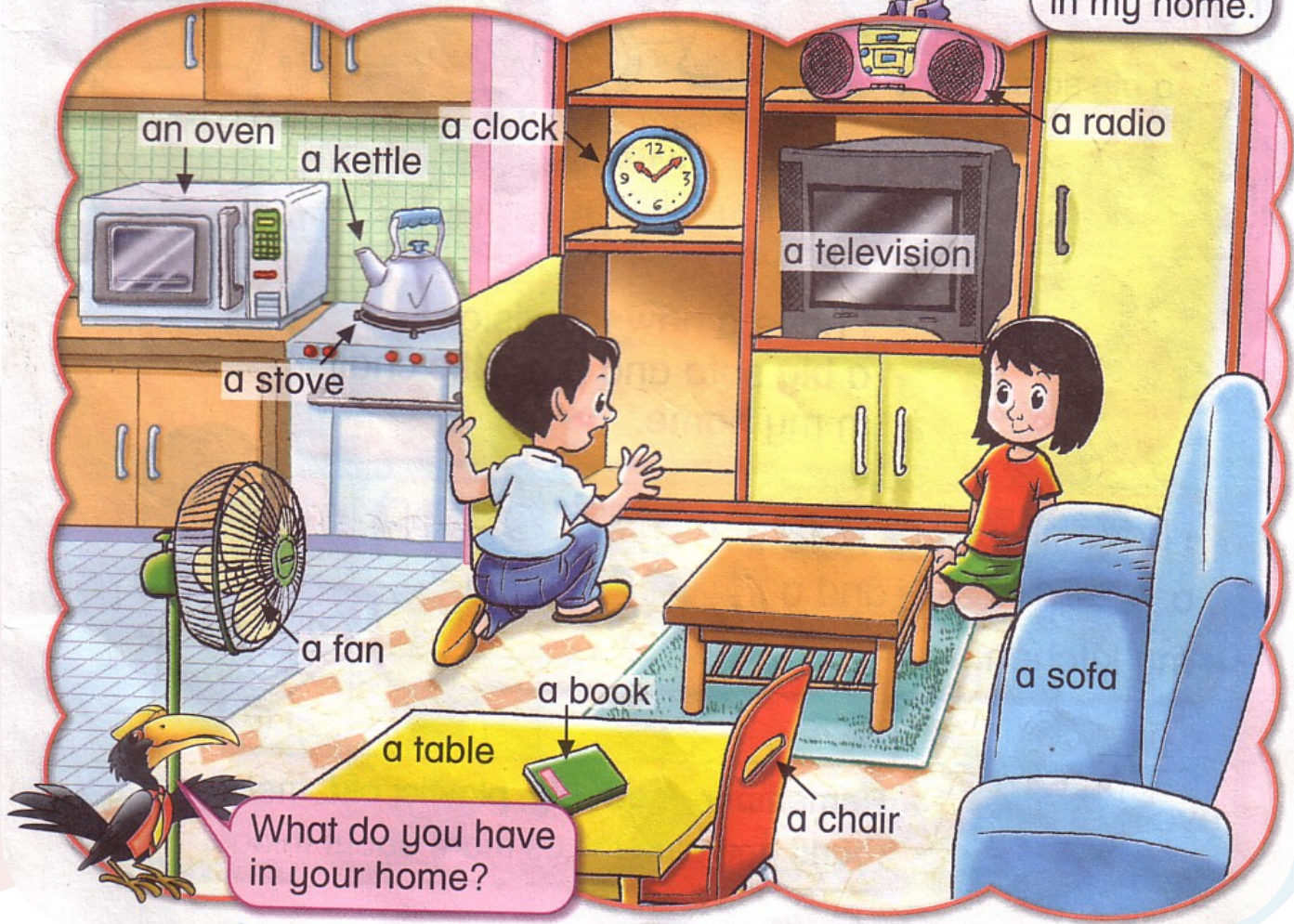

How *many* / *much*; quantifiers before nouns

How **much** light is there?

a lot of

There's **some** light.

a little

There isn't **much** light.
any

Much



Many

➔ **MUCH** is used with **uncountable nouns**. It is mainly used in negative and interrogative clauses.

Examples

- How **much** money have you got?
- We didn't spend **much** money.
- There isn't **much** data to download.
- I'm sorry but I don't have **much** time.
- Too **much** water drowned the miller.

➔ **MANY** is used with **countable nouns**. It is mainly used in questions, affirmative sentences & negations.

Examples

- I don't have **many** friend.
- There are too **many** disadvantages in this business.
- How **many** children do you have?
- Are there **many** poor people in France?



Separable two words phrasal verbs

I **take out** the garbage.

I **take** the garbage **out**.

I **take it out**.

Not: ~~I take out it.~~

Could you **hang up** your clothes, please?

Could you **hang** your clothes **up**,
please?

Could you **hang** them **up**,
please?

*Not: ~~Could you hang up them,
please?~~*
